T20 Packing for Northern Tier (2024) 8/10/2023

Clothes should be light and fast-drying synthetic or wool. No cotton.

Packing space on the boats is very limited.

Use good judgement when selecting gear. Some items should be waterproof or stored in waterproof containers.

Gear for the Water (on your body):

- □ NT-APPROVED BOOTS (~\$100, recommend buy NT).
- □ Light, long-sleeved T-shirt.
- □ Light, long pants (recommend zip-off legs).
- □ 1 pair socks.
- □ 1 pair underwear.
- □ Light belt or suspenders.
- Wide-brimmed hat or ball cap (recommend chin strap).
- □ Whistle (w/ leash).
- □ Sunglasses (w/ float strap).
- □ 1L water bottle (wide mouth, w/ carabiner & leash).

Personal Dry Bag (in boat crew's "whale" pack):

- □ Waterproof dry bag (20-30L).
- □ Camp shoes (closed heel & toe, hard sole).
- □ Stuff sacks or Ziploc bags for organization.
- □ Warm hat (fleece or knit).
- □ Fleece jacket.
- □ Light, long-sleeved T-shirt.
- □ Light, long pants (recommend zip-off legs).
- \Box 2x extra pairs socks.
- □ Extra pair underwear.
- □ Sleeping pad (can carry outside of your personal dry bag).
- □ Camp towel or hand towel (small).
- □ Sports bra (if needed).
- □ Long underwear (optional, synthetic or wool).
- □ Pillow (optional, inflatable or stuff sack).

Sleeping Bag (in boat crew's "whale" pack):

□ Compact synthetic sleeping bag (~30F).

Other Personal Gear (in top of boat crew's "whale" pack):

- Durable rain jacket with hood.
- □ Headlamp.

Boat Gear (work together to bring as a boat crew):

- Drybag or daypack.
- □ Bug repellent (non-deet).
- □ Sunscreen (waterproof, high SPF).
- □ Small first aid kit (hand injuries, blisters, etc.).
- □ Pocketknife (small, w/ leash).
- □ Compass (baseplate type, w/ leash).

- □ SPF lip balm (recommend leash cap, *smellable).
- □ Eyeglasses (if needed, w/ float strap).
- □ Sports bra (if needed).
- □ 2-3 Epi-pens / inhalers (if needed).
- □ Bandanna or synthetic neck gaiter (optional).
- □ Watch (optional).
- □ Minnesota fishing license (optional).
- □ Paddling gloves (optional).
- □ Personal Type III PFD (optional, NT provides).
- □ Personal paddle (optional, NT provides).
- □ Notepad and pen (optional).
- □ Smellables bag (Ziplock or stuff sack w/ name on it):
 - \circ \quad Toothpaste (mini tube or dehydrated balls).
 - \circ ~ Toothbrush (small, folding or collapsing).
 - \circ ~ Gold Bond foot powder (small bottle).
 - $\circ \quad \text{Extra headlamp batteries.}$
 - $\circ \quad \ \ \, \text{Feminine hygiene products.}$
 - \circ Spork or spoon.
 - o Bowl.
 - o Cup.
 - Medications (if needed, primary set).
 - Contact lens supplies (if needed, lenses, solution, case, etc.).
 - Lens cleaner wipes for glasses (if needed).
 - o 6-12 Baby wipes (optional).
- □ Waterproof compression bag for sleeping bag.
- □ Head Net (*Minnesota's state bird is the mosquito*).
- Durable rain pants (optional).
- □ Multitool (including pliers / wire cutter, w/ leash).
- □ Map & map case (Troop-provided).
- □ Camera (optional, w/ cards, batteries, & float strap).
- □ Binoculars (optional, w/ float strap).
- □ 1-2 camp chairs (optional, Crazy Creek type).
- □ Fishing pole and small tackle kit (optional).

Base Camp & Travel Gear (in small daypack or duffel):

- □ 2-4 sets Comfortable Class B's for travel & base:
 - o T-Shirt.
 - \circ Shorts.
 - o Underwear.
 - o Tennis shoes.
 - o Socks.
- □ Travel distractions.
- □ Full class-A uniform for arrival on-base.
- □ Camp towel.
- □ Money for travel snacks.

Troop Gear (Crew Leader and Advisors will bring):

- □ First aid / sewing / repair kit.
- □ Spices.

Do Not Bring:

- □ No fluids in spray cans/bottles.
- $\hfill\square$ No cell phones or other electronics on base or trail.
- □ No glass containers.
- □ No deodorant on trail. Deodorant only traveling and at base (after trek).
- □ No hammocks.
- \Box No rain ponchos.
- $\hfill\square$ \hfill No canoe chairs that strap or clip on canoe.
- $\hfill\square$ If it's not on the previous page, don't bring it.

- □ Spending money for Trading Post.
- □ Swim trunks (for sauna).
- □ Shower sandals.
- □ Medications (backup set for crew first aid kit).
- $\hfill\square$ Full toiletries bag for travel & base (mini bottles).
 - o Shampoo.
 - Soap or bodywash and pouf or washcloth.
 - \circ Toothbrush.
 - \circ Toothpaste.
 - Deodorant (solid won't melt).
- □ Fillet knife (optional).
- □ Lock for storage locker (optional).
